

CENTRAL COAST BADMINTON ACADEMY - RULES AND REGULATIONS

All CCBA members, guests, and coaches (hereinafter referred as 'participants') must thoroughly review all our rules and regulations before using the Central Coast Badminton Academy (hereinafter referred as "CCBA") facility. These rules & regulations are designed to allow all participants to enjoy the facility in a way that will be safe and productive. CCBA management reserves the right to vary and revoke these Rules & Regulations from time to time, in addition to make, vary and revoke any bye-laws which may consider necessary or desirable for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Company and the conduct of the participants. Any such changes will be notified to participants immediately. Please do not hesitate to contact the CCBA staff members should you have any questions.

GENERAL RULES

1. Participants must sign-in at the CCBA reception counter. Please have your identification document ready to show when checking in. CCBA staff reserve the right to refuse entry to any participants without proper identification.
2. Participants are required to sign the CCBA liability release form. This is required for insurance and liability purposes for CCBA facility.
3. All coaching is controlled by CCBA. Coaching is undertaken by qualified coaches appointed by CCBA and no other coaching is permitted.
4. CCBA reserves the right at any time without prior notice to set aside facilities for tournaments, exhibitions and other social activities.
5. CCBA cannot be held responsible for any service or equipment not being available for whatever reason. CCBA reserves the right to make alterations to the type of facilities provided, without notice and in its absolute discretion and CCBA shall not be liable for any loss occasioned by such alterations except in so far as such loss is by law incapable of exclusion.
6. Food and drinks must all be consumed in the designated areas within the facility. ABSOLUTELY no food or drinks are allowed on the playing area and badminton courts.
7. CCBA pro shop merchandises and services are sold "as-is" without any warranty.
8. CCBA does not allow smoking, gum chewing, or animals in the facility. Anyone found to be violating this policy will be required to leave the CCBA premises immediately without refund and may be barred from entering the CCBA premises in the future.
9. Children under the age of 12 must be under adult supervision at all times. Children over the age of 7 may not enter changing rooms or other areas reserved for the opposite sex, regardless of whether they are accompanied by an adult.
10. CCBA is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Items left on the premises will be kept for up to 7 days and donated to charity if not claimed.
11. Participants should not use any piece of equipment without prior instruction. Participants should ask CCBA staff on how to use new or unfamiliar equipment.
12. Participants must at all times observe CCBA's byelaws and guidelines which may be notified to them from time to time and are requested to comply with any reasonable directions which the management may issue to ensure the smooth operation of the sessions for the convenience of participants.

PERSONAL CONDUCT

1. Participants are subject to the control and guidance of the CCBA staff, and must follow their instructions while in the facility. Participants agree to conduct themselves in a quiet and well-mannered fashion when in the club and not cause any disturbances or interfere with the safe use or enjoyment of the sessions by other participants.
2. The development and use of appropriate language is promoted. Obscene language, gestures, swearing, profanity, blasphemy, and other offensive behaviour any kind is not allowed. Harassment is forbidden.
3. Participants shall not conduct, purchase or subscribe to any commercial business or activity on the premises or solicit other participants for any reason. Under no circumstances shall participants interfere with the CCBA's conduct of its business. Any complaints, other than those of an emergency nature or requiring immediate attention by the CCBA staff, shall be made directly to the management in private.

DRESS CODE

1. Participants are requested to wear suitable sport exercise clothing while at the CCBA facility. CCBA management reserves the right to deny entry to the club by any person whose attire is considered by the CCBA staff to be inappropriate in connection with the public image of the club and its rules and regulations. No profane language or slogans on any attire is permitted in the club.
2. Participants must wear appropriate light colour sole (non-marking or non-black sole), indoor sports, or badminton shoes ONLY while playing on the badminton courts. No bare feet/flip flops/hiking shoes/smart casual shoes allowed on the badminton court mats. Participants found violating this policy will have to leave the CCBA premises immediately and will not be entitled to any refund.

HEALTH CONCERNS

1. Participants should consult with their physician before using our services and facilities. Participants must understand and acknowledge that CCBA staff has no expertise in diagnosing, examining or treating any medical condition.
2. Participants agree that they will not use the CCBA facility with any medical condition including infections, maladies or inability to maintain personal hygiene, if such condition poses a direct health or safety of other Participants, and agree they will use the facility in accordance with all applicable public health requirements. CCBA management reserves the right, however, to make the final determination in this regard.

WAIVER AND RELEASE

Participants must sign the CCBA Waiver and Release of Liability form prior to commencing play.
